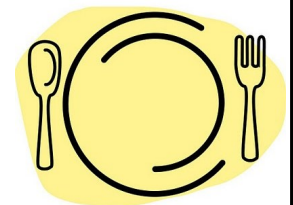


School Dinners Price Freeze!
