Short Breaks for Children and Young People with Special Educational Needs and/or Disabilities

Essex County Council

The Essex Short Breaks programme enables children and young people with special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND) and their families to join in with safe, entertaining and interesting activities, while allowing family members/carers the opportunity to have a break from their normal caring routine. They also give children and young people the chance to do fun and different activities to help build their confidence and independence. They are open to all children and young people with SEND who:

Are aged between 0-18 or 19-25 and in receipt of a personal budget

Have a diagnosis of special educational needs and/or a disability

Live within the borders of Essex County Council (excluding Southend and Thurrock as they have their own local offer of short breaks)
