This week in school the children took part in an Ashing Service to mark the beginning of the six weeks of lent.



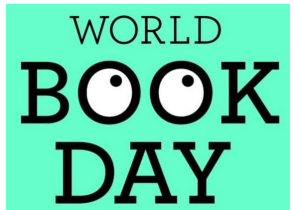
Well Done Maisie
