Well done to Year 1 who had the highest attendance figures of **97.67%** last week.

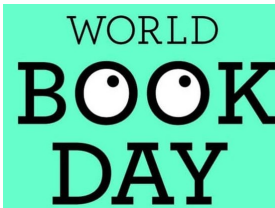

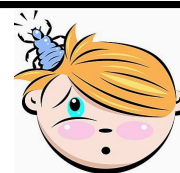
Bags 2 School
