Learning Council Assembly

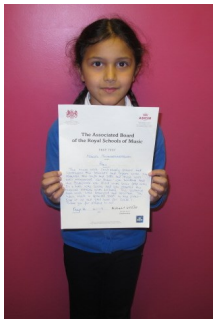
