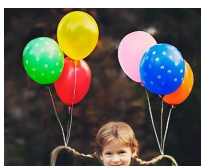

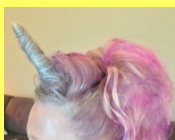


Break the Rules Day—25th October 2024
