Thank you to all the children who took part in our Christmas card project this year. Every purchase helps raise funds for the school.

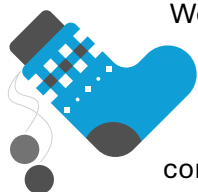
Break the Rules Day

School Lottery – Thank You for Supporting Us!

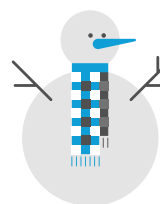


A huge thank you to everyone who takes part in our Parsons Heath School Lottery each week. Your entries this term have helped raise an extra boost for our funds and make a real difference.
